DAY 1 Depart from New York or Washington, DC for your flight to Johannesburg, South Africa on South African Airways.

Then upon arrival at Cape Town Airport, you will be met by a SAA Vacations representative and transferred to your hotel.

The backdrop of the Hottentots Holland Mountains, the white gabled Cape Dutch homesteads and the oak-lined streets and lanes all blend in to give this place a charm that will not be quickly forgotten. See some of the wine estates that were developed by early settlers who produced the wines sought after by Napoleon, Bismark and royalty such as Edward VII. Stop for a wine-tasting on an estate, where you will have the opportunity to purchase some of the wines.
